1. The following guidelines (hereinafter referred to as the Guidelines) are established in accordance with the Tai (87) Dian-Tzu-87019503 of the MOE, and the user-reimbursement guidelines.
2. The information appliance fee collected are to be use on management and maintenance of computers and network.
3. Information Appliance Fee and Services:
 - (1)NDHU provides students with individual email accounts, a variety of Internet services including WWW, BBS, NEWS, and related facilities including Computer Classrooms.
 - (2)NT\$300 is to be collected when registering at the beginning of each semester to cover the internet communication fee of that semester.
4. The following students are eligible for a refund when the refund list is confirmed in March and October every year:
 - (1) Those who study in other universities under the exchange program.
 - (2) Those who are dual enrolled at NDHU and charged the fee twice with registration.
5. Except (for) those who are described in Guideline No.4, there is no refund for the information appliance fee.
6. These rules and all amendments are implemented upon ratification by the Administrative Council and approval by the President.
